Monthly Settlement for October – Events Amy and Hans.

Amy:

The monthly settlement for October is now published in the claims and accounting system Meteor. In this context, we would like to point out that one company has had challenges with the transfer of claims data. This has been temporarily resolved by registering one collective claim, which in principle contains just over 2,000 individual claims, with a total provision of 66.1 million.

Adjusted for the missing registration of individual claims mentioned above, the Amy event at the end of the month stands at approximately 12,500 claims (with a provision above zero). The administration's estimate for the event overall is 15,000 claims and 1.8 billion, with an uncertainty interval from 1.5 to 2.1 billion.

Details on the individual claims, for the 2,000 registered under a collective claim, will first become visible under the event at the beginning of December.

Hans:

One claim was increased by 85 million at the end of the month, along with other increases totaling approximately 6 million. There is still uncertainty related to certain claims, and all insurance appraisals have not yet been completed. Based on this, it has been decided to introduce IBNER (Incurred But Not Enough Reported) for the event. The total estimate for Hans, as shown in Meteor as of 31.10.2025, is 3.1 billion, which includes an IBNER of approximately 491 million. In Meteor, IBNER appears in the column for IBNR.
